- Fluency in sign language, and current knowledge of relevant assistive technology.
- Experience with distance education technologies and digital learning.
- Ability to travel independently in rural/remote Alaska throughout the school year.

- Demonstrated experience in training professionals, paraprofessionals, and community members.
- Training/experience with students with multiple disabilities/autism.
- Comfort with networking and collaboration.

- Provide consultative services to district staff, students (3-21), and parents to include:
  - Individualized educational recommendations through onsite and distance delivery for students.
  - Assist with the development of student IEP and instructional program.
  - Evaluate student progress on an ongoing basis and recommend intervention strategies.
